Please complete the [boat arrival form](#) by Saturday 27th June, confirming your intended arrival and departure dates.

Boats may arrive from Tuesday 30th June To request permission to deliver the gig before this date please contact hello@cpga.co.uk.

Please note that any boats arriving prior to Tuesday will not be in the official parking area for the event and will be left at the club's risk.

If you are unexpectedly delayed and arrive after the car park is closed, please contact the number on the main gate.

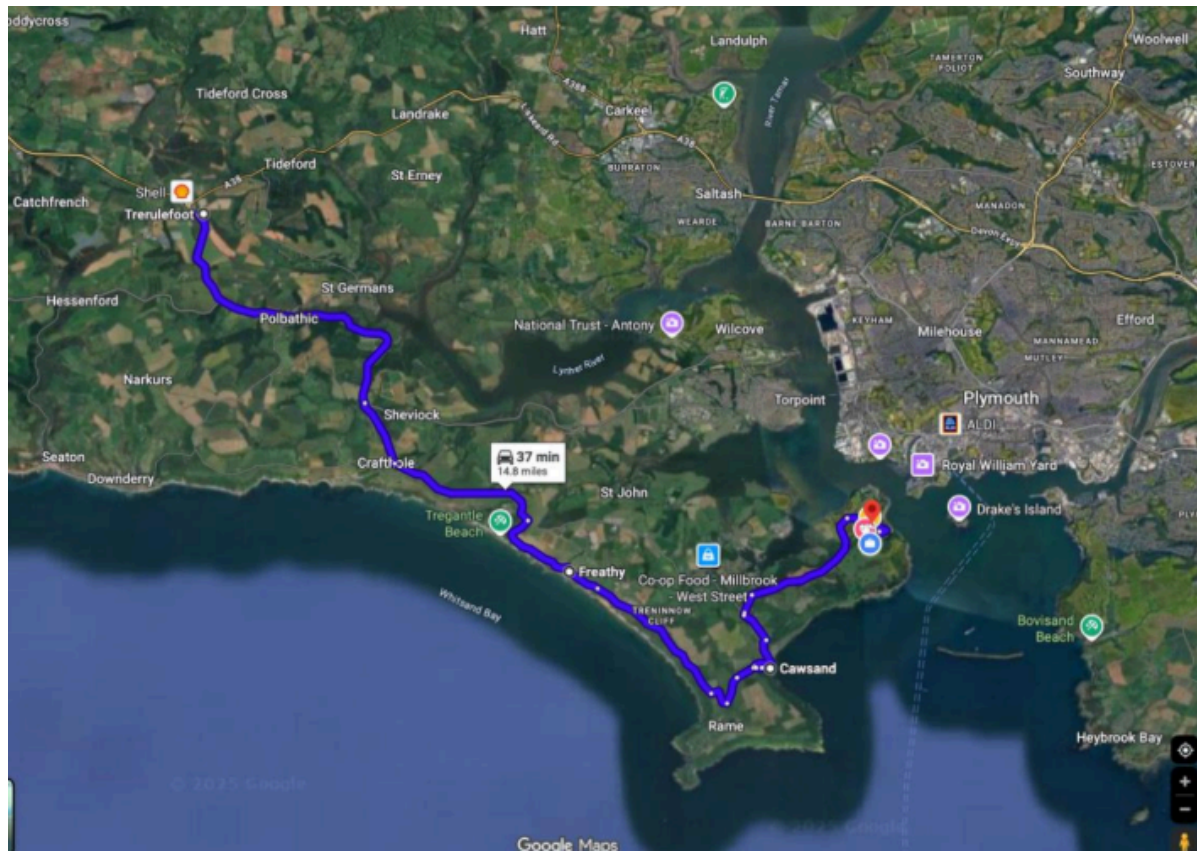
Gig Arrival Routes

CRITICAL: Do NOT drive through St Johns and Millbrook

Do not follow SatNav directions once you leave the A38 or Torpoint Ferry. SatNav routes will direct towing vehicles through unsuitable roads and villages where gig trailers cannot safely pass.

There are two approved traffic routes into Mount Edgcumbe, one from the A38 and one from Torpoint Ferry. Please do not follow any SatNav but the information that is shared here.

Gig delivery route from the A38 - Route A



Route A

From A38 Trerulefoot follow the A374 for 4.1 miles through Polbathic then right onto B3247 to Crafhole, through to Tregantle, passing the parking and viewpoint on your left side.

Pass the fort and then immediately turn right to Freathy Cliffs.

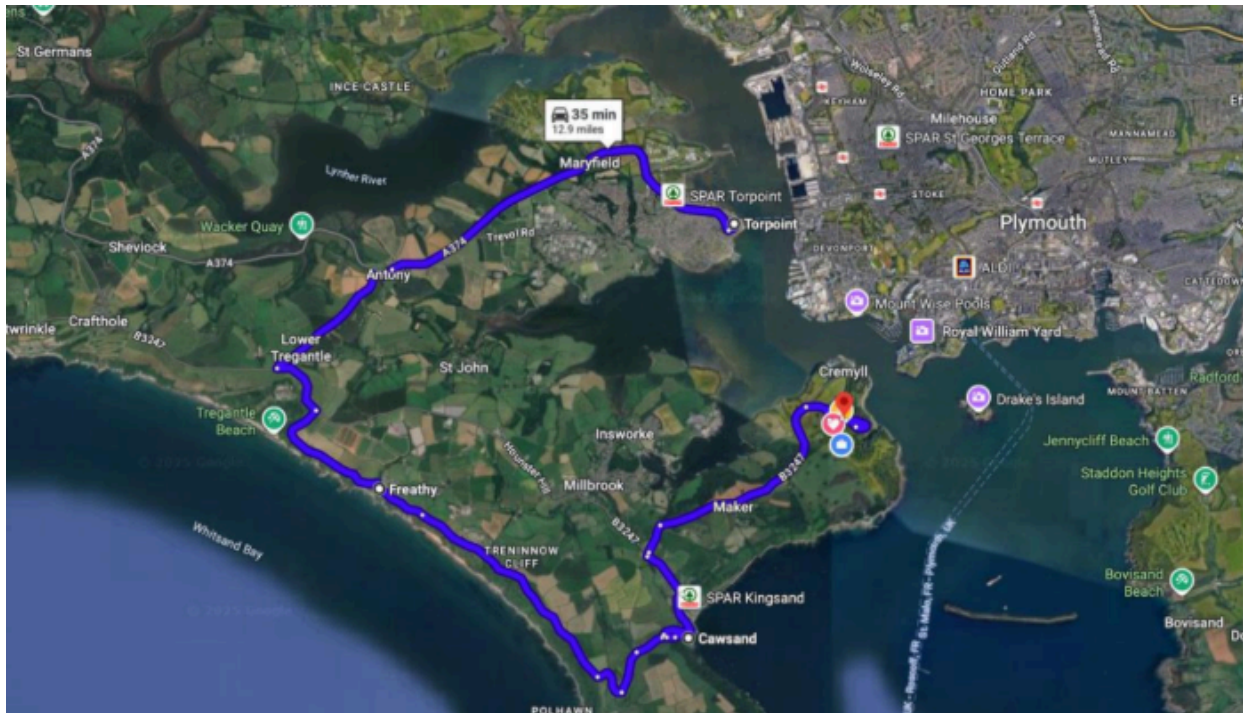
Continue on the cliff road to Cawsands and past Cawsands until you come to school on the right.

Turn right onto B3247 towards Mount Edgcumbe Country Park and continue downhill towards Cremyll.

Drive past the main entrance to Mount Edgcumbe Country Park (gated archway) and continue downhill towards Cremyll

Turn right into the manned gateway for Chapel Lands Car Park which is the parking area for towing vehicles and cars attending the event.

Gig delivery route from Torpoint Ferry - Route B



Route B

From Torpoint Ferry A374 drive towards Anthony past Anthony House (on your right).

Continue on the A374 (do not take St Johns turning).

At the Tregantle T-Junction turn left.

Pass the fort and then immediately turn right to Freathy Cliffs.

Continue on the cliff road to Cawsands and past Cawsands until you come to school on the right.

Turn right onto B3247 towards Mount Edgcumbe Country Park and continue downhill towards Cremyll.

Drive past the main entrance to Mount Edgcumbe Country Park (gated archway) and continue downhill towards Cremyll

Turn right into the manned gateway for Chapel Lands Car Park which is the parking area for towing vehicles and cars attending the event.

Gig Unloading

All gigs competing on Thursday 2nd July must be unloaded from trailers and moved by trolleys down to Barn Pool between 7.30am and 8.30am, via the route pictured below.

Pink area = trailer storage **Turquoise route** = road to Barn Pool

Green and **Yellow areas** - gig stored here overnight



At Barn Pool you will require chocks / trigs for bow/stern, and you may opt to use a roller on the beach.

After the racing has concluded boats will remain on Barn Pool Green overnight (there is no need for them to be reloaded onto trailers at the end of each day).

You may choose to use your covers on your gigs overnight and leave any equipment with your boats. Marshals will regularly patrol the area overnight. However, equipment is left at owners' risk.

All remaining gigs racing on Friday should be moved down to Barn Pool between 7.30am and 8.30am on Friday morning.

Any remaining gigs due to race on Saturday should be moved down to Barn Pool between 7.30am and 8.30am on Saturday morning.

Recovering Gigs

Once a gig has completed all scheduled racing, it may be returned to its trailer using club trolleys.
