Travel Guide

We look forward to welcoming you to Mount Edgcumbe. The local area features passing places and narrow lanes. Please be considerate of residents and other road users, waiting for others to proceed and pass safely.

Please consider car sharing where possible. Public transport routes are also available.

All event road traffic must follow either Route A - A38 or Route B - Torpoint Ferry as outlined below.

CRITICAL: Do NOT drive through St Johns and Millbrook. To avoid this please do not follow SatNav directions once you leave the A38 or Torpoint Ferry.

Gig Arrivals

Campers - all vehicles

Please follow Routes A or B, as specified below **BUT** instead of passing the Mount Edgcumbe main entrance please drive through the gateway onto the estate and follow the camping signs to Barrow Field.

Day Visitors (non-campers) - all vehicles

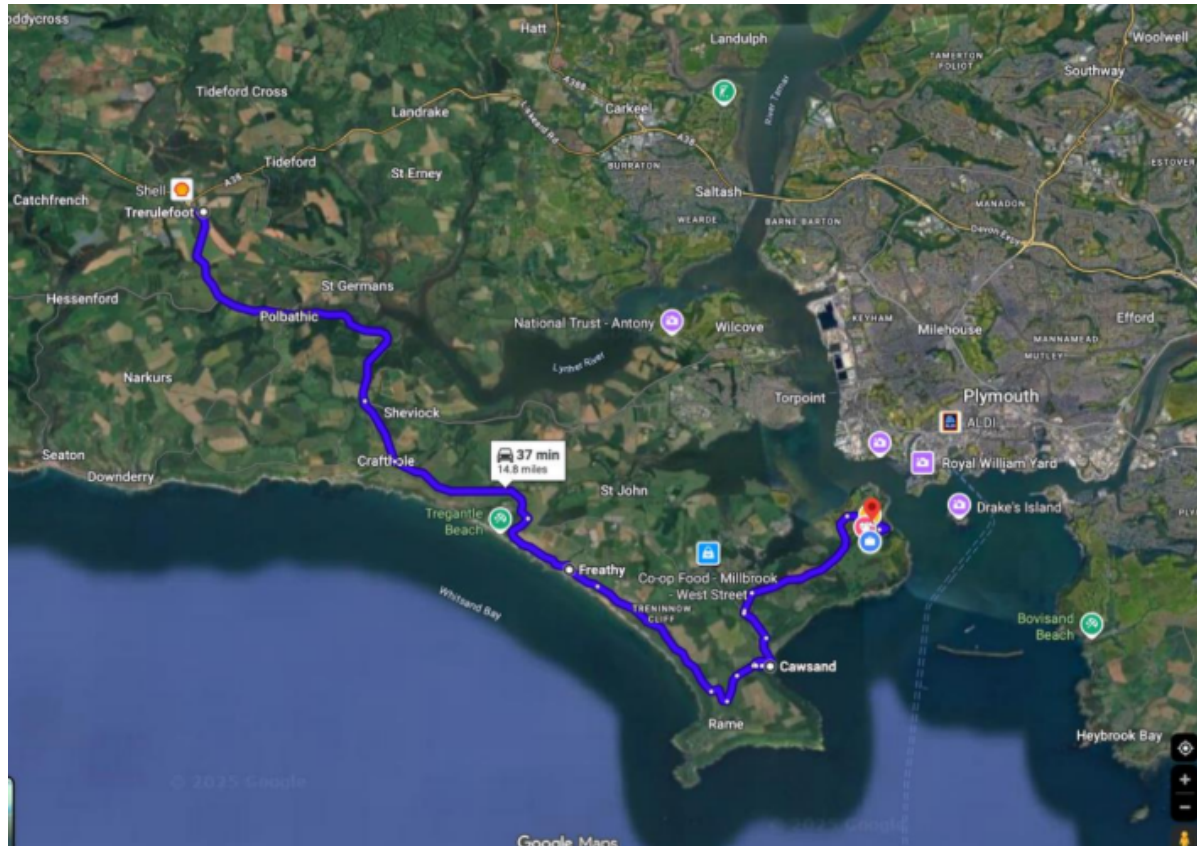
Please follow Routes A or B, as specified below to the Chapel Land Car Park

Chapel Land car park will be open daily from 7am until midnight, when the gates will close.

Please observe a 5MPH speed limit in the car park and always apply your handbrake when parked.

CRITICAL: Do NOT drive through St Johns and Millbrook

Gig delivery route from the A38 - Route A



Route A

From A38 Trerulefoot follow the A374 for 4.1 miles through Polbathic then right onto B3247 to Crafhole, through to Tregantle, passing the parking and viewpoint on your left side.

Pass the fort and then immediately turn right to Freathy Cliffs.

Continue on the cliff road to Cawsands and past Cawsands until you come to school on the right.

Turn right onto B3247 towards Mount Edgcumbe Country Park and continue downhill towards Cremyll.

Drive past the main entrance to Mount Edgcumbe Country Park (gated archway) and continue downhill towards Cremyll

Turn right into the manned gateway for Chapel Lands Car Park which is the parking area for towing vehicles and cars attending the event.

Gig delivery route from Torpoint Ferry - Route B



Route B

From Torpoint Ferry A374 drive towards Anthony past Anthony House (on your right).

Continue on the A374 (do not take St Johns turning).

At the Tregantle T-Junction turn left.

Pass the fort and then immediately turn right to Freathy Cliffs.

Continue on the cliff road to Cawsands and past Cawsands until you come to school on the right.

Turn right onto B3247 towards Mount Edgcumbe Country Park and continue downhill towards Cremyll.

Drive past the main entrance to Mount Edgcumbe Country Park (gated archway) and continue downhill towards Cremyll

Turn right into the manned gateway for Chapel Lands Car Park which is the parking area for towing vehicles and cars attending the event.

Passenger Ferry

The Cremyll Ferry operates daily for foot-passengers from Admirals Hard in Plymouth and takes approximately 7 minutes. Visit the Cremyll Ferry website to find out more.

By Car Ferry

The Torpoint Car Ferry is available at approximately 10-minute intervals and queues form in high season. From Torpoint use A374 and B3247 (brown signs) via Antony. Allow approximately 40 minutes travel time (30 minutes off peak).

By Bus

Bus services operate from both Cornwall and Plymouth via Traveline South West journey planners.

By Train

The closest train station to Mount Edgcumbe is around 8 miles away at St Germans. Alternatively, take the train to Plymouth, then walk or take a bus to the Cremyll Ferry and travel by boat to Mount Edgcumbe.
